ATCC® Medium 3: Nutrient agar or nutrient broth

**Growth Conditions**  
**Temperature:** 26.0°C

## Propagation Procedure

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
2. From a single tube of #3 broth (5 to 6 ml), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 ml with a Pasteur or 1.0 ml pipette and use to rehydrate the entire pellet.
3. Aseptically transfer the rehydrated pellet back into the broth tube. Mix well.
4. Incubate the tube at 26°C for 24 to 48 hours.
5. After growth has been achieved, use several drops of the suspension to inoculate an additional broth tube, a #3 agar slant and/or a plate.

## Notes

Colonies on #3 agar are glistening, smooth, irregular, flat, and white.
