

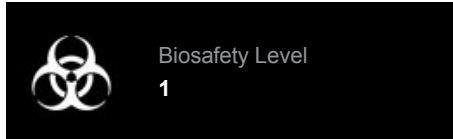

# *Saccharothrix mutabilis*

## *subsp. capreolus* (ATCC® 23892™)

### Intended Use

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### Description

**Deposited Name:** *Streptomyces capreolus* Stark et al.

### Propagation

#### Medium

ATCC® Medium 196: Yeast malt extract agar

#### Growth Conditions

**Temperature:** 26.0°C

#### Propagation Procedure

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
2. Using a single tube of #1877 broth (5 to 6 ml), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 ml with a Pasteur or 1.0 ml pipette. Rehydrate the entire pellet.
3. Aseptically transfer this aliquot back into the broth tube. Mix well.
4. Use several drops of the suspension to inoculate a #196 agar slant and/or plate.
5. Incubate the tubes and plate at 26°C for 24-36 hours.

### Notes

Colonies on #196 agar have yellowish, pink aerial mycelium at 13 days. Growth is poor on glucose.
