#### **Propagation Procedure**

- 1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
- From a single tube of #416 broth (5 to 6 mL), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 mL with a Pasteur or 1.0 mL pipette and use to rehydrate the entire pellet.
- 3. Aseptically transfer the rehydrated pellet back into the broth tube. Mix well
- 4. Use several drops of this suspension to inoculate a second tube of broth, a slant and/or a plate.
- 5. Incubate tubes and plate at 30°C for 48 hours.



#### Notes

After 48 hours, growth is evident by turbidity in the broth and the formation of small colonies on the slant and/or plate. Growth is best in broth culture or on biphasic slants. Only scant growth is observed on agar.

On #416 colonies appear pinpoint and gray. Growth is best in broth culture or on biphasic slants. Additional information on this culture is available on the ATCC web site at www.atcc.org.
