### Intended Use

### Complete Growth Medium

RPMI 1640 medium with 0.1 mM hypoxanthine, 90%; fetal bovine serum, 10%

Culture Medium: RPMI medium 1640 with HT

(containing: hypoxanthine, 10(-4) M;

thymidine, 1.6 x 10(-5) M), 90%; fetal bovine serum, 10%.

Cells do not do well if hypoxanthine and thymidine are omitted.

### SAFETY PRECAUTION

ATCC highly recommends that protective gloves and clothing always be used and a full face mask always be worn when handling frozen vials. It is important to note that some vials leak when submersed in liquid nitrogen and will slowly fill with liquid nitrogen. Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vessel exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris.

### Unpacking & Storage Instructions

1. Check all containers for leakage or breakage.
2. Remove the frozen cells from the dry ice packaging and immediately place the cells at a temperature below -130°C, preferably in liquid nitrogen vapor, until ready for use.

### Handling Procedure for Frozen Cells

Part A. FROZEN CELLS

Vol./Ampule: 1.0 mL.

Recommended Handling Upon Receipt: Initiate culture as soon as possible upon receipt. Thaw by rapid agitation in 37°C water bath. See instructions on back.

Dilute ampule contents with culture medium (see batch data above). Add fresh medium (depending on cell density) every 2-3 days.

### Handling Procedure for Flask Cultures

Part B. FLASK CULTURES

Recommended Handling Upon Receipt:

Suspension Cultures: The culture flasks have been completely filled with medium for shipment. Remove the entire contents of the flask and centrifuge at 300 x g for 15 minutes. Resuspend the cell pellet as suggested under subculture procedure described above.

### Subculturing Procedure

**Medium Renewal:** Every 2 to 3 days

Cultures can be maintained by addition or replacement of fresh medium. Start cultures at 1 X 10 exp5 cells/ml and maintain between 1 X 10 exp5 and 1 X 10 exp6 cells/ml.

### Comments

Animals were immunized with glycoprotein fraction from the Bristol 8 human B lymphoblastoid cell line.

Spleen cells were fused with NS-1 myeloma cells.

This line is a switch variant of Genox 3.53 (ATCC HB-103).

An IgG2b switch variant of Genox 3.53 also exists (G2b.2, ATCC HB-109).

Tested and found negative for ectromelia virus (mousepox).
