Salmonella enterica subsp. enterica strain TA 1537 is a whole-genome sequenced strain with applications in enteric disease research, infectious disease research, and zoonotic disease research. This bacterium is the HisC3076, rfa-, uvrB derivative of strain LT-2.

Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vial exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris. Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

Handling Procedures

- 1. Open thawed vial.
- 2. Aseptically transfer the entire contents to a 5-6 mL tube of #3 broth.

 Additional test tubes can be inoculated by transferring 0.5 mL of the primary broth tube to these secondary tubes.
- 3. Use several drops of the primary broth tube to inoculate a #3 plate and/or #3 agar slant.
- 4. Incubate at 37°C for 24 hours.
