Handling Procedures

Transfer a loopful to a test tube containing 5 mL LB \pm 20 mg/mL of chloramphenicol broth. A loopful of culture can also be streaked on an LB \pm chloramphenicol agar

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plate. Incubate cultures at 30°C. Isolate DNA using standard plasmid preparation procedures.
