Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

## **Handling Procedures**

1. Open vial.
  2. Rehydrate the entire pellet with approximately 0.5 mL of #129 broth.  
Aseptically transfer the entire contents to a 5-6 mL tube of #129 broth.  
Additional test tubes can be inoculated by transferring 0.5 mL of the primary broth tube to these secondary tubes.
  3. Use several drops of the primary broth tube to inoculate a #129 plate and/or #129 agar slant.
  4. Incubate at 37°C for 24 hours.
