Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vial exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris. Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

### **Handling Procedures**



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- 1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
- 2. Using a single tube of #1877 broth (5 to 6 ml), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 ml with a Pasteur or glass pipette. Rehydrate the pellet.
- 3. Transfer this aliquot back into the broth tube. Mix well.
- 4. Use several drops of the suspension to inoculate a second tube of broth, one or two slants and/or a plate.
- 5. Incubate all tubes and plate at 26°C for two to three days.

#### Notes

Colonies are wrinkled, irregular, and pale orange.
