Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vial exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris. Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

Growth Conditions

Temperature: 26°C

Handling Procedures

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
2. From a single tube of #1877 broth (5 to 6 ml), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 ml with a Pasteur or 1.0 ml pipette and use to rehydrate the pellet.
3. Use 0.1 ml of this suspension to inoculate #196 slants and 0.1ml to inoculate #196 plates.
4. Incubate tubes and plates at 26°C, under aerobic conditions, for approximately 7 days.

Notes

Colonies are circular, entire, convex, and beige. Colonies become whitish with aerial mycelium formation. Substrate mycelium is orange. Cells are Gram variable pleomorphic rods.
