Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vial exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris. Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

Growth Conditions

Medium:

ATCC Medium 1527: PY-glucose (ATCC medium 1524) with 10 g glucose per liter of medium

Temperature: 37°C

Atmosphere: Anaerobic

Handling Procedures

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
 2. Under anaerobic conditions, withdraw 0.5 ml of the appropriate medium from a single test tube (5 to 6 ml) and rehydrate the entire vial contents.
 3. Aseptically transfer this aliquot back into the broth tube. Additional tubes with 0.5 ml each from the suspension. Streak onto a blood plate and incubate aerobically to check for purity.
 4. Incubate tubes under an anaerobic atmosphere at 37°C.
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Notes

In 48-72 hours, growth is evident by slight turbidity. No growth should occur on agar plates incubated aerobically. Cells are motile rods that occur singly and in pairs. Colonies are entire, glistening, circular, smooth, and pinpoint.
