



# ***Nonomuraea thermotolerans* Wu and Liu**

## **Description**

*Nonomuraea thermotolerans* strain 3-33-9B is a bacterial type strain that was isolated in 2012 from solid compost. The depositor states that this strain has abundant aerial mycelium.

Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vial exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris. Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

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## Growth Conditions

**Medium:**

ATCC Medium 2869: HV Medium

ATCC Medium 334: Oatmeal agar

ATCC Medium 260: Trypticase soy agar/broth with defibrinated sheep blood

**Temperature:** 50°C**Atmosphere:** Aerobic

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## Handling Procedures

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1. Open thawed vial.
  2. Aseptically transfer the entire contents to a 5-6 mL tube of #2869 broth. Additional test tubes can be inoculated by transferring 0.5 mL of the primary broth tube to these secondary tubes.
  3. Use several drops of the primary broth tube to inoculate a #2869 plate and/or #2869 agar slant.
  4. Incubate at 50°C for 14 days.
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## Notes

Spores are spherical to cylindrical. Smooth spore sheath surface.

Grows on #2869 in 14 days, #334 in 7 days, and #260 in 5 days.
