For cultures that require storage in liquid nitrogen, it is important to note that some vials may leak when submersed in liquid nitrogen and will slowly fill with liquid nitrogen. Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vial exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris. Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

Growth Conditions

Medium:

ATCC Medium 461: Castenholz TYE medium

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ATCC Medium 260: Trypticase soy agar/broth with defibrinated sheep blood

Temperature: 37°C**Atmosphere:** Aerobic

Handling Procedures

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
2. Using a single tube of #461 broth (5 to 6 ml), withdraw approximately 0.6 ml with a Pasteur or 1.0 ml pipette. Rehydrate the entire pellet.
3. Aseptically transfer 0.3 ml of this suspension back into the broth tube. Mix well.

4. Use the remaining 0.3 ml of the suspension to inoculate a slant of #260 or #461 agar.
 5. Incubate tubes at 37°C for 24 hours.
 6. Once growth is obtained in broth, plates can be inoculated with approximately 0.2 ml per plate
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Notes

Turbid growth should be visible in broth after 24 to 48 hours of incubation. After 24 to 48 hours, colonies on #461 plates are yellow/orange, irregular, flat, erose and have a darker center. On #260 agar, the colonies exhibit a-hemolysis with a green discoloration of the media.
