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ATCC highly recommends that appropriate personal protective equipment is always used when handling vials. For cultures that require storage in liquid nitrogen, it is important to note that some vials may leak when submersed in liquid nitrogen and will slowly fill with liquid nitrogen. Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vial exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris. Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

Handling Procedures

Unpacking and storage instructions:

1. Check all containers for leakage or breakage.
2. Remove the frozen cells from the dry ice packaging and immediately place the cells at a temperature below -130°C, preferably in liquid nitrogen vapor, until

ready for use.

Complete medium: Alpha minimum essential medium (Eagle), 90%; heat-inactivated horse serum, 10%

Handling Procedure: Part A. FROZEN CELLS

Vol./Ampule: 1.0 mL.

Recommended Handling Upon Receipt: Initiate culture as soon as possible upon receipt. Thaw by rapid agitation in 37°C water bath. See instructions on back.

Dilute ampule contents with culture medium (see batch data above). Add fresh medium (depending on cell density) every 2-3 days.

Subculturing procedure:

Medium Renewal: Every 2 to 3 days

Cultures can be maintained by addition or replacement of fresh medium. Start cultures at 2×10^5 cells/ml and maintain between 1×10^5 and 1×10^6 cells/ml.
