Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

This virus is a genetic variant of the Urabe AM9 strain which has been administered as a vaccine without an excessive number of adverse reactions. It differs in passage history and nucleotide sequence from the Urabe AM9-derived vaccine strains. It has been fully sequenced (GenBank accession no. [AF314558](#))
