- Water contaminant known to cause “bever fever”.
- Microsporidia species implicated in groundwater contamination. (Abbreviated)
- Waterborne protozoan genus that has been linked to primary amoebic meningoencephalitis.
- Intestinal infection caused by *Shigella*.
- Pseudomonad used in the quality control of pharmaceutical water. (Abbreviated)

- Virus that can cause paralysis or death.
- The MS2 _____ is a recommended control used to test water for organisms after purification. (Hint: See ATCC® 15597-B1™)
- Biofilm-forming bacterial genus used to facilitate coagulation in wastewater treatment.
- Double-stranded RNA virus common in domestic wastewater.
- Bacterial pathogen found in freshwater fish. (Abbreviated)
- Cyst-forming coccidian protozoan known to cause traveler’s diarrhea. (Abbreviated)
- Gram-positive species used in the quality control of pharmaceutical water. (Abbreviated)
- Slow-growing bacterial pathogen known to cause skin lesions. (Abbreviated)
