

Growth Conditions

Temperature: 26.0°C

Propagation Procedure

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
2. From a single tube of #1877 broth (5 to 6 ml), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 ml with a Pasteur or 1.0 ml pipette and use to rehydrate the pellet.
3. Use 0.1 ml of this suspension to inoculate #196 slants and 0.1 ml to inoculate #196 plates.
4. **Incubate tubes and plates at 26°C, under aerobic conditions, for 14 days.**
5. After 14 days of incubation, wash cells from the slant and transfer this broth to a new slant and plate. Incubate another 14 days under aerobic conditions. This second transfer and incubation is necessary for complete removal of the cryoprotectant, which can inhibit growth.

Notes

At 14 days, mature aerial mycelia appear as a gray to purple hue on #196 plates. No soluble pigment is produced.
