## Propagation

### Medium

ATCC® Medium 2: Marine agar 2216 or marine broth 2216

### Growth Conditions

**Temperature:** 30°C

**Atmosphere:** Aerobic

### Propagation Procedure

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
2. Using a single tube of #2 broth (5 to 6 mL), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 mL with a Pasteur or 1.0 mL pipette and use to rehydrate the entire pellet.
3. Aseptically transfer this aliquot back into the broth tube. Mix well.
4. Use several drops of the suspension to inoculate a second tube of broth, an agar slant and/or plate.
5. Incubate the tubes and plate for 24 to 48 hours at 30°C.

## Notes

This strain has two colony types. The most prevalent one is entire, glistening, smooth, and translucent. The secondary type is also entire, glistening, and smooth; but is much more opaque and slightly larger. There is also some segmentation (single colonies showing both characteristics in segments).
