Propagation Procedure

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
2. Using a single tube of #18 broth (5 to 6 mL), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 mL with a Pasteur or 1.0 mL pipette. Rehydrate the pellet.
3. Aseptically transfer this aliquot back into the broth tube. Mix well.
4. Use several drops of the suspension to inoculate a #18 agar slant and/or plate.
5. Incubate the tubes and plate at 30°C for 48 hours.

Notes

Strain has two colony types that have been individually characterized and found to be biochemically identical. The two colony types at 24 hours are smooth, glistening and have entire edges. However, the colony types changes in morphology at 48 hours. At 48 hours the colony types are (a) large, circular, coarse, whitish and opaque; and (b) small, circular, less dense than colony type a and translucent.
