Preparation Procedure

Centrifuge tube prior to opening to prevent loss of pelleted material

1. Rehydrate the contents of the vial with molecular grade H₂O. DNA is dried in Tris.
2. Place vial at 37°C for 1 hour or at +2°C to 8°C overnight.
3. For more complete rehydration and to fully recover DNA, incubate the sample at 65°C for 1 hour or overnight at 4°C. Resuspending the dried DNA in >250 µL may give better results.
4. To enhance PCR efficiency add 1 µl freshly prepared dry milk powder solution to 50 µl PCR reaction. A ?hot start? to the PCR protocol is also recommended.
5. Clean PCR product.
