## Propagation

### Medium

ATCC® Medium 1522: Trypticase soy medium (ATCC medium 18) with 8 mcg/ml of tobramycin

### Growth Conditions

**Temperature:** 37°C  
**Atmosphere:** Aerobic

### Propagation Procedure

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions or visit [www.atcc.org](http://www.atcc.org) for instructions.
2. Rehydrate the entire pellet with approximately 0.5 mL of #1522 broth. Aseptically transfer the entire contents to a 5-6 mL tube of #1522 broth. Additional test tubes can be inoculated by transferring 0.5 mL of the primary broth tube to these secondary tubes.
3. Use several drops of the primary broth tube to inoculate a #1522 plate and/or #1522 agar slant.
4. Incubate at 37°C for 24 hours.

## Notes

Colonies on #1522 agar appear smooth, entire, circular, glistening, opaque and cream. Depositors claim multidrug resistance to amikacin, aztreonam, carbenicillin, cefoperazone, cefotaxime, ceftiofur, chloramphenicol, ciprofloxacin, mezlocillin, piperacillin, tetracycline, and tobramycin (see reference). ATCC could confirm antibiotic resistance only to cefoxitin and tobramycin.
