Temperature: 37.0°C

Propagation Procedure

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
2. From a single tube of #18 broth (5 to 6 ml), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 ml with a Pasteur or 1.0 ml pipette and use to rehydrate the entire pellet.
3. Aseptically transfer the rehydrated pellet back into the broth tube. Mix well.
4. Use several drops of the suspension to inoculate an agar slant and/or plate.
5. Incubate the tubes and plate at 37°C for 24 hours.

Notes

Colonies on #18 plates the colonies are entire, glistening, circular, smooth, raised, and opaque. It exhibits β-hemolysis on sheep blood agar. It also produces coagulase.
