## **Propagation**

### **Medium**

ATCC® Medium 18: Trypticase Soy Agar/Broth

### **Growth Conditions**

**Temperature:** 37.0°C

### **Propagation Procedure**

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
2. From a single tube of #18 broth (5 to 6 ml), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 ml with a Pasteur or 1.0 ml pipette and use to rehydrate the entire pellet.
3. Aseptically transfer the rehydrated pellet back into the broth tube. Mix well.
4. Use several drops of the suspension to inoculate an agar slant and/or plate.
5. Incubate the tubes and plate at 37°C for 24 hours.

## **Notes**

Colonies on #18 plates are entire, glistening, smooth, circular, and orange.
