ATCC® Medium 260: Trypticase soy agar/broth with defibrinated sheep blood

Growth Conditions

Temperature: 37.0°C

Propagation Procedure

- Using a single tube of #44 broth (5 to 6 ml), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 ml with a Pasteur or 1.0 ml pipette. Rehydrate the entire pellet.
- Aseptically transfer this aliquot back into the broth tube. Mix well.
- Use several drops of the suspension to inoculate a #260 agar slant and/or plate.
- Incubate the tubes and plate at 37°C for 24 hours.

Notes

Colonies on #260 plates are pinpoint, entire, glistening, circular, smooth, and translucent. Incubation under 5% CO₂ enhances growth.
