**Designation:** 313

**Deposited Name:** *Lactobacillus leichmannii* (Henneberg) Bergey et al.

**Product Description:** Used in the assay of vitamin B<sub>12</sub> [cobalamin]. Formerly *Lactobacillus delbrueckii* subsp. *lactis*. *Lactobacillus delbrueckii* subsp. *lactis* is a heterotypic synonym.

## Propagation

### Medium

ATCC® Medium 416: Lactobacilli MRS Agar/Broth

### Growth Conditions

**Temperature:** 37°C

**Atmosphere:** 5% CO<sub>2</sub>

### Propagation Procedure

1. Open the vial according to enclosed instructions.
2. From a single tube of the recommended broth (5 to 6 mL), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 mL with a Pasteur or 1.0 mL pipette and use to rehydrate the entire pellet.
3. Aseptically transfer the rehydrated pellet back into the broth tube. Mix well.
4. Use several drops of this suspension to inoculate a second tube of broth, a slant, and/or a plate.
5. Incubate all tubes and plate at 37°C for 24 to 48 hours in an atmosphere of 5% CO<sub>2</sub>.

## Notes

Growth is generally best in broth or on biphasic slants and may be poor on agar plates and slants.

This item also grows better on Sheep Blood agar plates.
