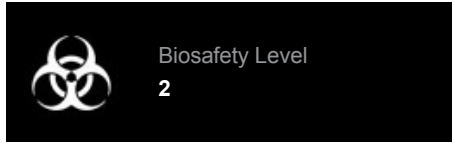

## Description

**Deposited Name:** *Diplococcus pneumoniae* (Klein) Weichselbaum  
**Antigenic Properties:** Type 34 (Danish designation 10A)

## Propagation

### Medium

ATCC® Medium 260: Trypticase soy agar/broth with defibrinated sheep blood

### Growth Conditions

**Temperature:** 37.0°C

### Propagation Procedure

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
2. **Using a single tube of #44 broth (5 to 6 ml), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 ml with a Pasteur or 1.0 ml pipette. Rehydrate the entire pellet.**
3. **Aseptically transfer this aliquot back into the broth tube. Mix well.**
4. **Use several drops of the suspension to inoculate a #260 agar slant and/or plate.**
5. Incubate the tubes and plate at 37°C for 24 hours.

## Notes

Colonies on #260 agar are small, entire, glistening, circular, smooth, flat, and exhibit  $\alpha$ -hemolysis. Incubation under 5% CO<sub>2</sub> enhances growth.

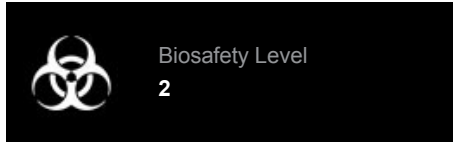
