Comments

The virus localizes and multiplies in the brain and spinal cord. Inoculation by the s.c. route elicits good antibody formation in mice but not in the guinea pig. Little or no serological cross-reactions occur with Anopheles A antigens. It is more stable in 50% glycerol than in lyophilized form but has been found viable after storage in wet-frozen state at -70° for 10 years.
