**Description:** Viral nucleic acids, including virus genomic DNA, in total DNA isolated from MRC-5 cells (ATCC® CCL-171™) infected with Human herpesvirus 5 (VZV) strain Ellen (ATCC® VR-1367™). Virus and host cells are also available through the ATCC® Catalog. This product was prepared using methods known to inactivate viruses.

**Note:** DNA isolated from virally infected cells is appropriate for PCR and other molecular virology applications.

### Batch-Specific Information

### Preparation Procedure

1. Thaw the vial at room temperature and immediately place on ice. Avoid exposing the DNA to repeated freeze-thaw cycles as it may result in degradation of the DNA.
2. Gently mix the sample to ensure an even distribution of material.
3. Briefly centrifuge the tube before opening to ensure all liquid is at the bottom.

### Quality Control Information

1. Integrity is inferred from observation of DNA amplicon following PCR as visualized on ethidium bromide stained agarose gel.
2. Functional activity is demonstrated by RT-PCR and dilutability of amplicon as visualized on ethidium bromide stained agarose gel.
3. Identity is confirmed by sequence analysis of the PCR amplicon.
4. Absence of infectious virus is verified following incubation of  $\geq 10\%$  of each lot with susceptible host cells under appropriate conditions.

### Biosafety Level: 1
